Recruitment of Resource Person on Sessional Basis

The National Women's Council is inviting applications from qualified candidates who wish to serve as Resource Person on a sessional basis in Adult Literacy Course in the National Women's Council (NWC). Candidates should possess:

- (1) **Age:** Between 25 to 50 years
- (2) **Qualifications:**
- (a) Cambridge School Certificate with credits in at least five subjects obtained at not more than two sittings or
 - (b) Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject
or
 - (c) An equivalent qualification acceptable to the Board.
- Experience in teaching in Adult Literacy Classes is desirable.
- (3) **Fees Payables:** Rs230 per session of 1 ¼ to 1 ½ hrs up to maximum of 40 session per month.

(4) **Mode of Application**

Interested candidates should submit their applications on the prescribed form which may be obtained during office hours at the Reception of the National Women's Council, 1st Floor, London Centre, Remy Ollier Street, Port Louis or on Website: nwc.govmu.org.
